

PUBLIC NOTICE

The community is invited to review and comment on draft plans for the remediation of several sites along Canal Street. These sites and activities include planned asbestos abatement and tank removal at the former Rolfite site, soil removal at the former Samarius site, soil vapor extraction for contamination in the soils at the former Axton Cross site, and the planned in-situ treatment of a contaminated groundwater plume below the former Axton Cross and Cel-lastik industrial sites.

The hearing is being conducted during the regular meeting of the Citizens Advisory Board of the City of Shelton by the City of Shelton and the Shelton Economic Development Corporation. All citizens are welcome.

The work is under design and financially supported in large part by the U. S. EPA's brownfields program, the CT Department of Economic and Community Development, and the Valley Council of Governments. The site work is being managed by the Shelton Economic Development Corporation (SEDC) and its Licensed Environmental Professional, under the State of Connecticut's Department of Environmental Protection's voluntary remediation or urban sites remedial action programs.
